Hormones. Describes a specific tissue or organ to which a hormone binds. Target tissue (organ) Describes, for example, this sequence of events: corticotropin-releasing hormone (CRH) stimulates the release of adrenocorticotrophic hormone (ACTH), which in turn stimulates the secretion of cortisol; as the blood level of cortisol increases, it shuts off the further secretion go ACTH and CRH.
