Open a Lock with a Paper Clip

Most safes are constructed from heavy steel and can be opened in a variety of ways. One way to open a safe is with a combination dial. The dial moves tumblers inside the locking mechanism to align them in the correct pattern to open the safe. Dials on safes can have a "slip" of one or two numbers depending on how the lock was made.

The grooves and cuts of the bump key are designed at their maximum depth so that they can be used on multiple locks. However, the key has to at least match the keyway of the lock it is being used on. To bump a lock, the bump key is inserted into the keyway and pressure is applied via a hammer or a screwdriver.

Straighten out the second paper clip. Pinch the end of the paper clip with the pliers and bend the long part 90 degrees to form the first ridge in the rake. Move the pliers down on the long part of the paper clip, and bend again at 90 degrees. Keep doing this until you have 3 ridges in the paper clip.
