Post-traumatic stress symptoms were assessed using the 30-item Stanford Acute Stress Reaction Questionnaire (SASRQ), a DSM-IV-correspondent scale that assesses symptoms of ASD, including dissociation, re-experiencing of trauma, avoidance, anxiety and hyper-arousal, and impairment in functioning.

The Posttraumatic Stress Diagnostic Scale(PDS) is a 49-item self-report measure designed to assess all the DSM-IV diagnostic criteria for PTSD.<sup>22,23</sup>The PDS, which is based on the self-report counterpart of the PSS-I (PSS-SR) is the only stand-alone instrument that assesses all DSM-IV criteria.<sup>18</sup>It was designed as a screening instrument to identify PTSD in the general population or in a population of trauma survivors.

The Secondary Trauma Stress Scale (STSS), is a 17-item questionnaire that measures the frequency of secondary traumatic stress symptoms over the past month. Questions on the STSS addresses issues with intrusion, avoidance and arousal symptoms similar to those found in PTSD.
