Characteristics of the Short Story

Whilst orientation, complication and resolution are the agreed norms for a narrative there are numerous examples of popular texts that did not explicitly follow this path exactly. Although narratives can take many different forms and contain multiple conflicts and resolutions nearly all fit this structure in way or another.

Writing an Engaging Short Story with Well-Developed ...

The plot of a short story follows the following structure: Exposition / Orientation: A brief introduction to the character (s), setting (s) and the main idea of the story. Conflict / Complication. A problem or issue which arises, creating tension and interest, which must be dealt with for the story to be resolved.

Short Story Project: Elements of the Short Story

The resolution is the part of a story in which the action falls. This is often referred to as the falling action. In the resolution, the complication is resolved, i.e. the characters are able to solve their problems. 5.

A Complication is when a problem or a dilemma disrupts the normal life or comfort of the characters and sets off a sequence of interesting events. The complication, often in the form of an obstacle (physical or emotional) that needs to be overcome, creates tension or excitement for the reader of the story and usually needs a response from the main character. It serves the following purposes: It builds suspense and increases the feeling of tension surrounding the central conflict or question of the story. It moves the plot forward, brining it to the point of climax, which enables the story to reach a resolution.
