Squid PROCEDURE: Part I - External Anatomy: 1) Place the squid on the plastic plate dorsal side up (darker side). Notice the counter shading. One side is darker than the other. 2) Notice and label on the squid diagram the chromatophores .

A. Teasing or Dissection needle which used to pull apart muscle tissue, B. Dissecting scissors which is used to cut through tissue, and. C. Forceps, which is used to lift and move cut tissue. Figure 2 shows different types of dissecting pins. Dissecting pins are used to hold the squid in place in the dissecting tray.

Place the squid with the dorsal (back) side up in the dissecting pan. This means put the side with the funnel down and the fin side up. Make sure the tentacles and arms are towards you. Locate the head, eyes, beaks (mouth), arms (8), two longer feeding tentacles, fins, mantle, and skin.

Lay the squid dorsal side down on a piece of wax paper laid over some newspapers. Lay the squid with its head to the left and its siphon opening upward (Fig. 3.71.1). Reach under the animal and remove the pen from the dorsal side by grasping it firmly with your fingers and pulling it free from the mantle. Using a scalpel or dissecting scissors, cut the mantle from its anterior edge next to the siphon to its posterior tip.

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The squid draws water into the mantle, the mantle contracts, and the water is forcefully expelled through the siphon.
